Reading aloud to children, starting at birth, helps build brain connections during the first five years (when 90% of a child's brain development happens).

Pre-reading skills don't just assist with word and letter recognition, they promote confidence and help children communicate their own thoughts and ideas.

Children who develop strong early literacy skills are more likely to succeed academically, exhibit higher levels of selfconfidence, and actively engage in learning experiences

Dolly Parton's Imagination Library is dedicated to inspiring a love of reading by gifting books free of charge to children from birth to age five.

Since the program began in our area, 968 children have graduated the program (reached the age of 5).
Currently 695 children receive books monthly but we have a waiting list of children that we are unable to enrol due to funding constraints.

Building a Love of Reading One Book at a Time

It's easy to understand how important it is to ensure all children have access to books and how it will encourage early literacy and set children up for success, but DPIL is so much more! We asked some children and their parents to come see us with some of their favourite Dolly Parton Imagination Library books, and guess what happened? A story broke out! (Well, actually many stories.) Parents read to children, siblings read to younger siblings, and everyone enthusiastically told us about their favourite books (even when they couldn't pick just one!). Current State of the Dolly Parton Imagination Library in our Region

Enrolment: 695 ~ 25% of population, 958 children have graduated (reached age of 5)

Program is funded by generous donations from our business community and FSJLS fundraising activities. Without funding consistency, we've been unable to grow the program or maintain enrolment numbers. We've had no active marketing of the program in many years as we know the interest would overwhelm our opportunity to ensure the funding for participants until they reach the age of 5. Even without marketing, our wait list continues to grow and many children "age out" without ever being enrolled.
